A step-by-step guide to finding, enrolling in, and completing courses on the HealthHIV National HIV E-learning Training Center.

Find Your Course

Go to healthhiv.org/elearningcenter to browse the full library of e-learning courses. Use the **Subject** and **Audience** filters to narrow the list, or scroll through to see everything available.

- Sister to Sister: Take Control of Your Health**: A Training of Facilitators to Support HIV Prevention Among Women of Color. Description: This course was developed for clinic-based providers to empower women to reduce their risk for acquiring HIV. This blended course entails a 60-minute, self-paced E-Learning module developed by HealthHIV, followed by an in-person or virtual classroom session hosted by CAI.
- Covering Costs of HIV PrEP**: An eLearning Course for the HIV Prevention Workforce. Description: During this self-paced e-learning module, participants will review three cost components of HIV PrEP, and sources of insurance, and other key tools that PrEP educators can use to help their clients cover those costs and evaluate different options for covering costs based on the needs of clients in various situations. This module will prepare participants for beginning their work as PrEP educators as well as serve as a refresher for experienced professionals.
- Fundamentals of Rapid HIV Testing**: Description: This course prepares rapid HIV testing staff to conduct the key steps of rapid HIV testing: setting up a workspace, conducting the rapid HIV test, preparing clients for the test and delivering test results, and conducting quality assurance activities. Participants also have opportunities to reflect on how they can use what they've learned and apply it to their current work. Learners may save their reflections for the future as they grow their knowledge in the field.
- Strengthening Strategies that Support PrEP Adherence**: Description: This course helps health department staff and other public health professionals address barriers to adherence, monitor PrEP adherence, and develop partnerships to support adherence. A core part of course content will involve interactive components that help learners develop an action plan tailored to their specific situation.

2 Log In or Create Your Account

All courses are hosted on eHealthHIV, HealthHIV's learning platform. Visit ehealthhiv.org/login to log in or create a new account.

First time here? Select **Create New Account** and complete the registration form. Any field marked with an exclamation point is required. Once everything is filled in, select **Create My New Account**.

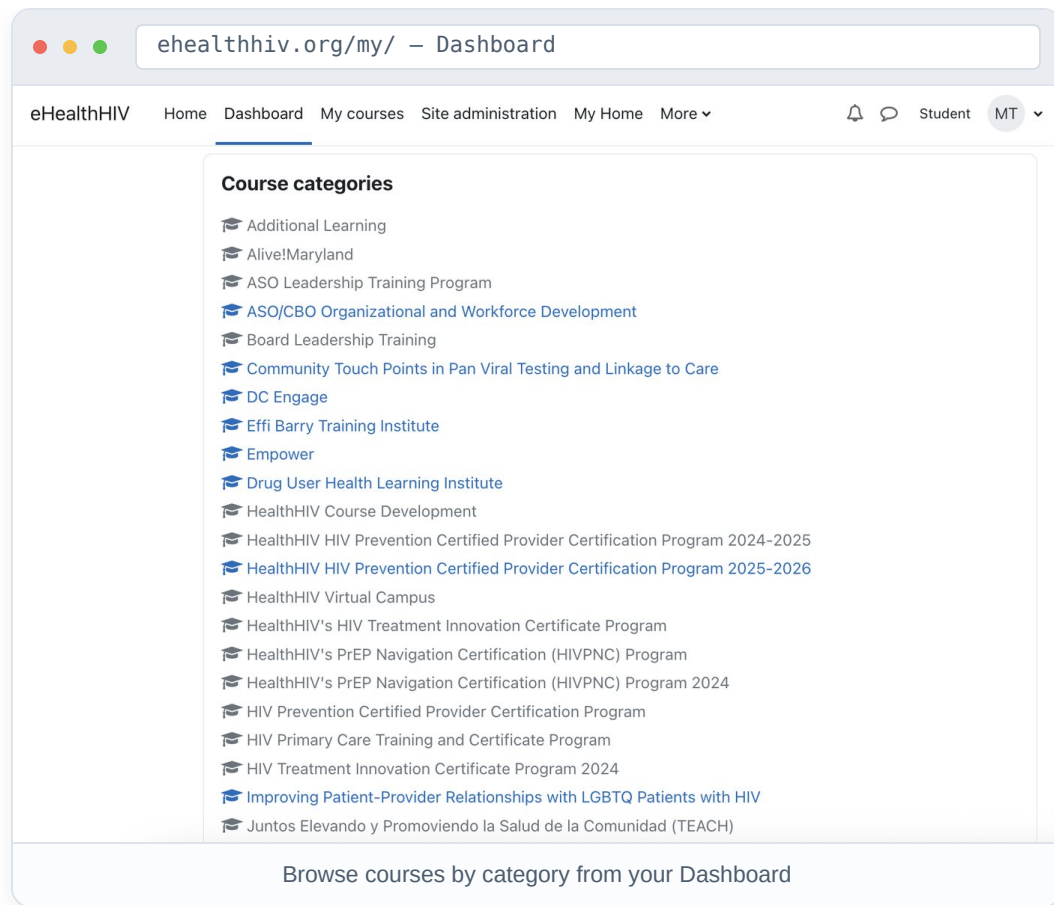
TROUBLE LOGGING IN?

Passwords are case-sensitive, so double-check your entry first. If you've forgotten your password, select **Lost Password?** on the login page and follow the reset instructions. Still stuck? Select the question-mark icon in the bottom-right corner of the screen for instructions on contacting site support.

3 Enroll in Your Course

There are two ways to find a course once you're logged in:

- **Search:** Select **Course Search** at the top of the screen and enter the course name.
- **Browse:** Select **Dashboard**, then **All Courses**, to explore courses by category.



Once you've found your course, open it, scroll to the bottom of the page, and select **Enroll Me**. To pick up a course you've already started, select **My Courses** at the top of the screen.

4 Track Your Progress & Get Your Certificate

Every course lists its components along the left-hand side of the screen, so you can always see what's left to finish:

● Green circle — component complete ○ Empty circle — not yet complete

Once every required component is marked complete, your certificate becomes available to download. If you can't access it, revisit the component list and finish any items still showing an empty circle.
